Volunteers will be needed for bag stuffing Friday night, packet pick up on Saturday, and on race day Sunday. We will need all hands on deck for Sunday.

7. Grand Prix Schedule: 6 races this year. Reds Shoe Barn 5 miler, Medical Center 6k, Bill Luti 5 miler, Sandown 5 miler, Auburn 10 miler, Footrace for the Fallen 5k./p>
8. Kids Summer Fun Runs: We have a conflict with a fitness camp being held on the Pinkerton track on our last scheduled week. We may have to drop 1 week and only have six weeks this year. Amy Bernard has contacted Director of camp and is trying to arrange a compromise. Sean has contacted the Athletic Director
9. Turkey Trot: Jim Ewell not present. Lengthy discussion about future of the race. The current Director feels with the amount of hours it takes to direct a race of this size that he should be compensated. His request is to receive \$1.00 per pre registered runner. If that request is not honored he requests GDTC relinquish the rights to the race to him. He would then hold the race on his own. It was decided that this was not a direction that we were willing to go. Jim Peters will notify the current Director that we will proceed with the race under new direction
